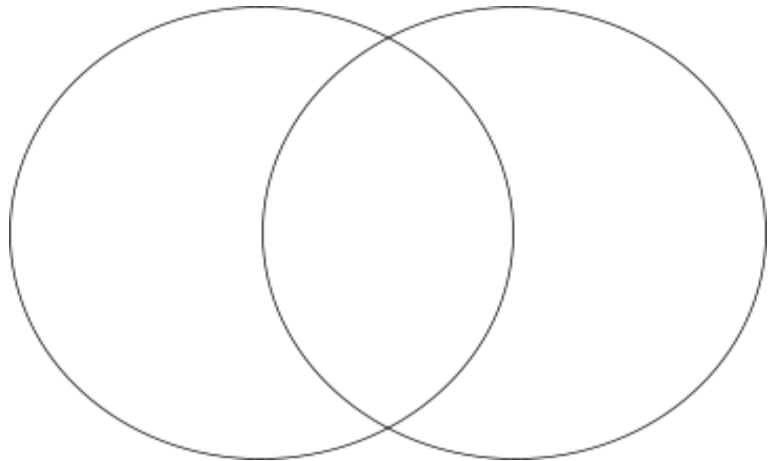
Look at the burrfish in the exhibit. What adaptations do they have to protect themselves?
