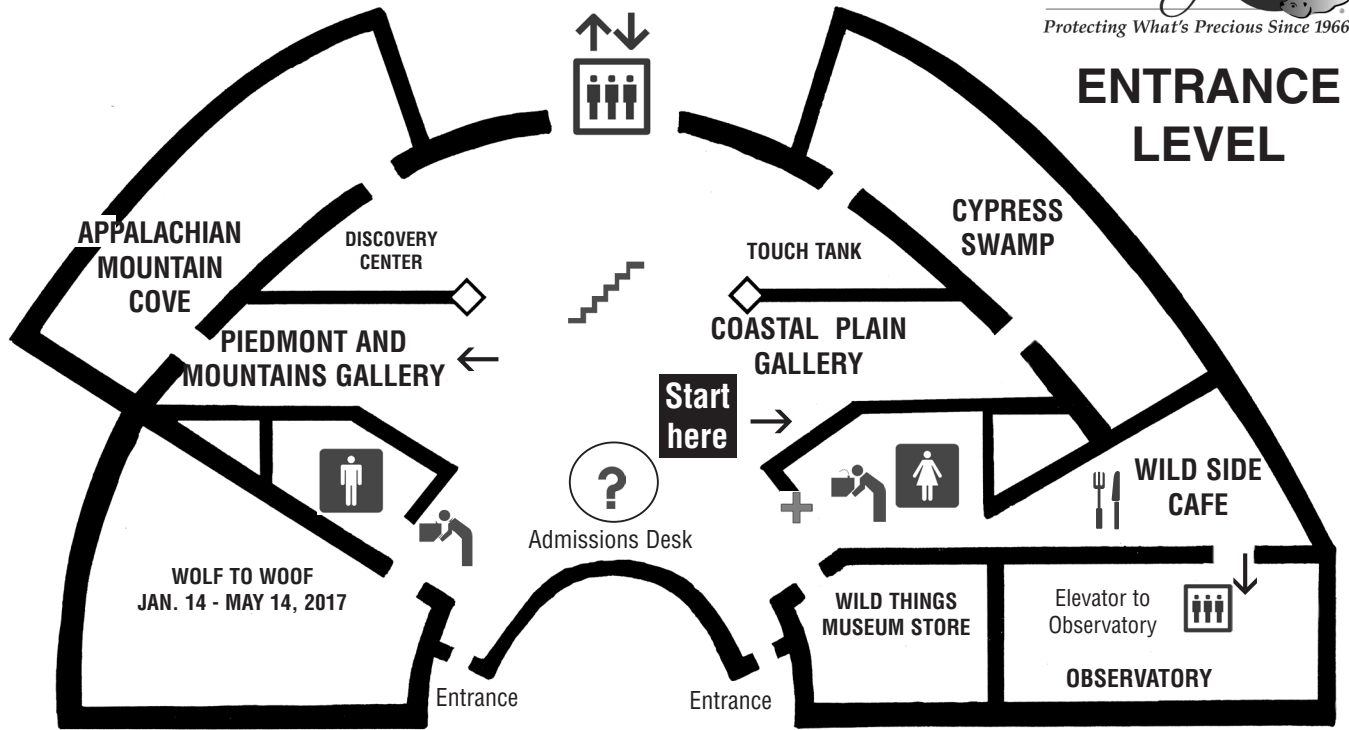

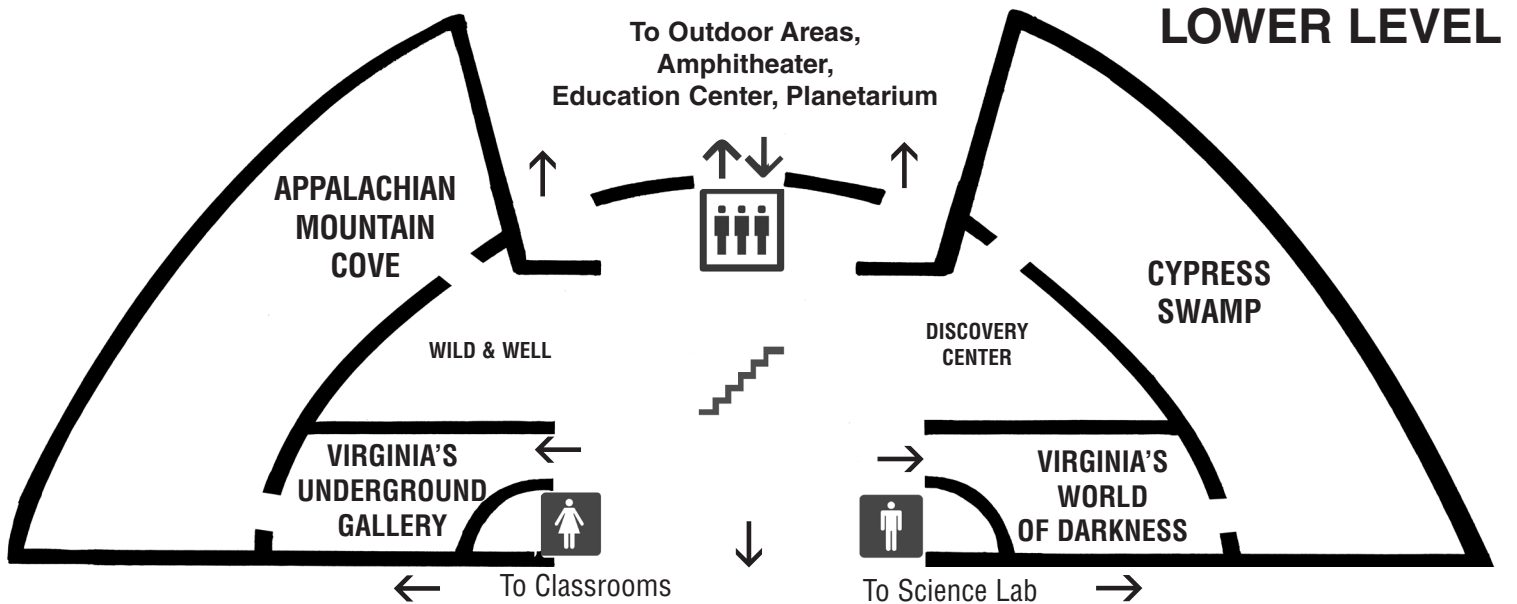

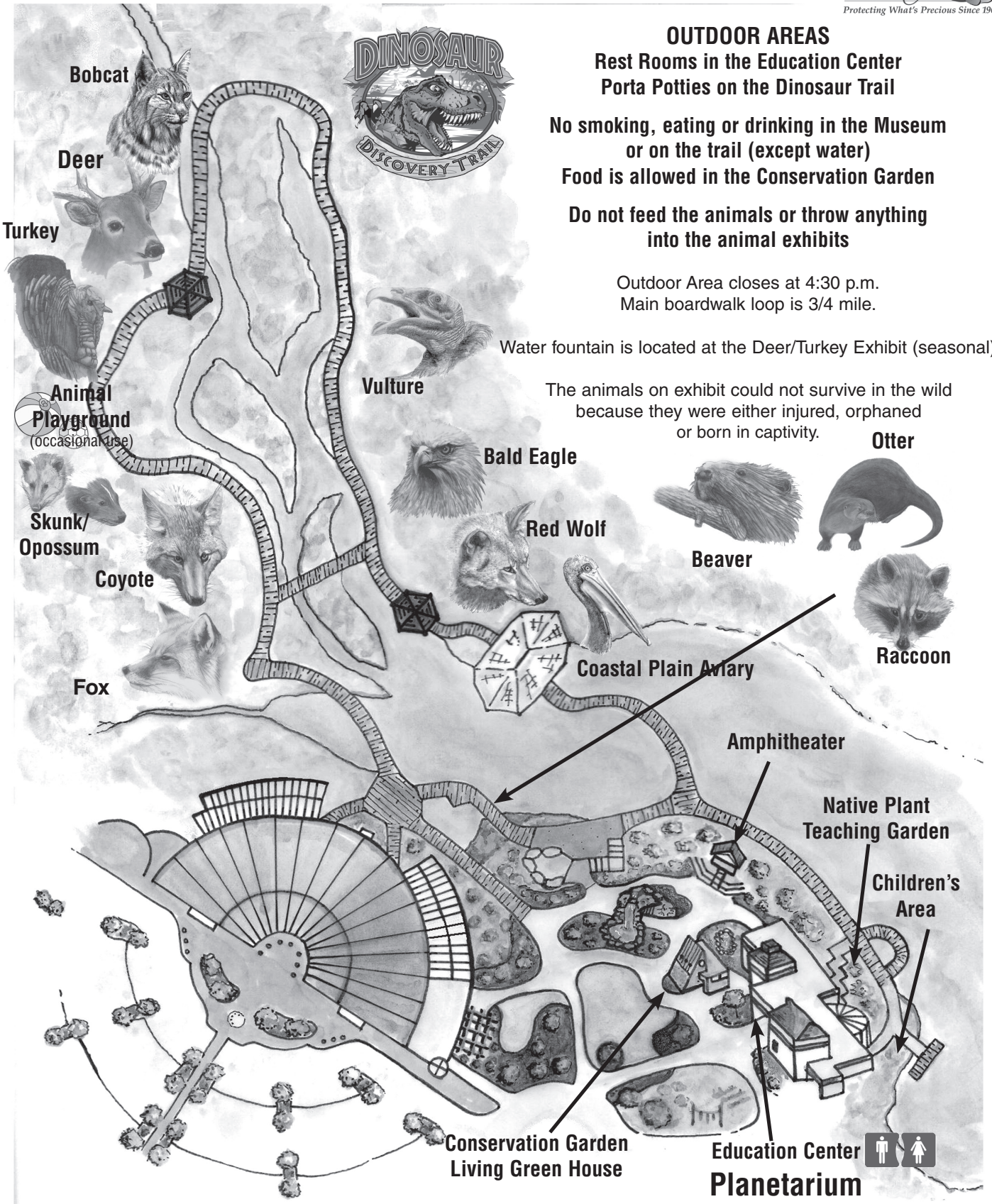

Outdoor Area closes at 4:30 p.m.  
Main boardwalk loop is 3/4 mile.

Water fountain is located at the Deer/Turkey Exhibit (seasonal)
